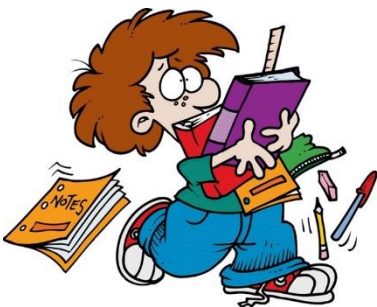
Charges – Extra Cost Options

** Camps and excursions are not guaranteed each year, they are planned at the discretion of the learning area teacher and administration. The costs listed below are estimated and are set at the upper limit. Charges are paid by parents / guardians prior to attending any of the listed options. The non-payment of these charges will be referred to a third party for collection if they remain unpaid.

SIDE – School of Isolated & Distance Education. All fees associated with student enrolment into SIDE programs will be billed to the parent unless it is being delivered as a whole school program or initiative.

Secondary Assistance Scheme (S.A.S.) & ABSTUDY

All secondary students (years 7-10) have been issued with information and enrolment forms for the SAS Scheme. \$235.00 is paid to the school for fees and parents receive a \$115.00 allowance for uniforms. Parents who receive Centrelink payments will need to apply for the ABStudy grant through their local Centrelink office. Please note that ABStudy is subject to attendance.
